Suit for - (i) partition and possession by metes and bounds by way of preliminary as well as final decree, with regards to Gair Mumkin residential house constructed in an area measuring 140 Square Yards consisting of three storied building i.e. two rooms, kitchen, latrine, bathroom, stairs and one shop on ground floor and the same portion on first and second floor along with electricity, water, sewerage connection, bearing M.C House Tax Unit No. B-18/137 (SRS/B/3/853), measuring 21 feet x 60 feet, bounded as on East-Gali Share-am measuring 21 feet, West-remaining portion of the property of Ashok Kumar measuring 60 feet, North-property of Ramsaran etc. measuring 60 feet South-property of Harmeet Singh measuring 60 feet situated in Multani Colony, Near Shiv Chowk, within MC Limits of Sirsa, Tehsil and District Sirsa, out of which the plaintiffs are having 1/3 share in their equal shares, defendant No.1 is having 1/3 share and defendant No.2 through his legal heirs are having 1/3 share in their equal shares and also for the delivery of the possession of the above said house, after partition of the same to the plaintiffs to the extent of their 1/3 share, from the defendants along with all rights of passage, path etc. and they are entitled to get their name entered and corrected in all the revenue records including M.C. Record. (ii) and as a consequential relief for permanent injunction, restraining defendants from dispossessing the plaintiffs from the joint possession of house in question forcibly and illegally and also from changing nature of the house and also from raising any construction thereon in any manner, further from alienating or transferring or subletting the suit property or its portion thereof in any manner, without getting it first partitioned and also from creating any type of charge, bar or lien over any specific portion of the above said house, till the final decision of the suit in any manner, on the basis of evidence of every description-oral and documentary.
