Suit to declare the plaintiff as owner of the Plot no.12 comprising 200 sq yds. at Royal Enclave Limited Residential Colony, Vill. Bhucho Kalan, District Bathinda, Punjab being legal owner by declaring the execution of sale deed bearing no.353 dated 09.05.2011 under fiduciary relationship to Defendant No.1 and mandatory injunction to pass order in the favour of plaintiff to execute the sale deed of Plot No.12 comprising 200 sq yds situated at Royal Enclave Limited Residential Colony, Vill. Bhucho Kalan, District Bathinda, Punjab in the favour of plaintiff by defendant no.1 and 2, further declare the effect of gift deed as null and void that was executed by Defendant no.1 in the favour of Defendant no.2 vide transfer/sale deed no.1815 dated 21.12.2020 registered at Sub Registrar, Nathana(Bathinda) as gift deed under blood relationship by ignoring the bonafide ownership of the plaintiff against the property Plot no.12 comprising 200 sq yds. Situated at Royal Enclave Limited Residential Colony, Vill. Bhucho Kalan, District Bathinda, Punjab as Plaintiff's and Defendant No.1 is not authorized to transfer Defendant No.2 in any manner as Defendant no.1 holding the plot only under the fiduciary relationship being a wife whereas all amount of plot and construction was paid from the pocket of Plaintiff time and again.
