

ARRANGEMENT IN CURRENT ROSTER W.E.F. 12.03.2026

Vide Notification No. K. 11017/01/2026-US.I/II dated 06.03.2026 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Justice, the President of India has been pleased to transfer Hon'ble Ms. Justice Lisa Gill to be a Judge of High Court of Andhra Pradesh.
