- (iv) In case, any pending matter(s) in an FIR/Complaint which is required to be allocated afresh before Hon'ble Bench and the same can be listed before two or more Hon'ble Benches, available in roster due to their previous listing status, then

the said matter will be placed before Senior Hon'ble Judge amongst them as per roster.

(v) Subsequent Application(s) for Suspension of Sentence under section 389 Cr.P.C. (u/s 430 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023) shall also be listed before the same Hon'ble Division/ Single Bench, who had earlier decided (on merit or disposed of/ dismissed as withdrawn for non-prosecution/not pressed) the Application for Suspension of Sentence filed by the same accused, if the same composition of Hon'ble Judges is available in roster.
