RE: INVITING SEALED QUOTATIONS FOR SUPPLY OF 16 BATTERIES OF 12V (65 AH) FOR THE ONLINE UPS AND EXECUTION OF RATE CONTRACT FOR 12V (42 AH) BATTERIES, 12V (65 AH) BATTERIES AND 12V (85 AH) BATTERIES WITH BUY BACK OPTION.

Invited sealed quotations from local market (within Tri-city) on or before **11.09.2025 upto 5.00 P.M.** for supply of 16 batteries of 12V (65 Ah) with buy-back of existing 16 nos. of batteries of same specification, for the online UPS and execution of a rate contract for 12V (42 Ah) batteries, 12V (65 Ah) batteries and 12V (85 Ah) batteries, with buy-back option, as per the following specifications:-

Specification:-

- 1) **16 batteries** – Specifications: 24M OB 65-12, 12V, 65Ah (Warranty-2Yrs/ Any Make)
- 2) **Rate Contract for :**
 - i. **42 Ah batteries** – Specifications: EP 42-12, 12V, 42Ah. (Warranty-2Yrs/ Any Make)
 - ii. **65 Ah batteries** – Specifications: 24M OB 65-12, 12V, 65Ah. (Warranty-2Yrs/ Any Make)
 - iii. **85 Ah batteries** – Specifications: 12V, 85Ah. (Warranty-2Yrs/ Any Make)

Terms & Conditions

1. The Quotations received within Tricity will only be entertained.
2. The rates should be F.O.R. High Court premises, inclusive of all taxes, levies, GST etc.
3. The article should be of reputed Brand.
4. Payment will be made only after receipt of complete supply to the satisfaction of this High Court and no advance payment will be made in any case.
5. While sending a quotation, the word **“SUPPLY OF BATTERIES FOR ONLINE UPS IN HIGH COURT”** may be inscribed on the sealed envelope.
6. The Rate Contract will be for one year, which may be further extended for one year, on the same rate, terms and conditions, provided satisfactory services to the satisfaction of the High Court.
7. The vendor who quoted the rates of Batteries will give an undertaking that the rates offered are the lowest possible. In case it is proved at any stage that the vendor has offered lower rates to anyone else for the same during the same period, the vendor will be liable to pay a differential amount to the High Court and face termination of the contract at the discretion of the High Court without notice.
8. The quotations received after the due date will not be considered.
9. The High Court reserves its right to accept or reject any proposal without assigning any reason.
10. The High Court can terminate the contract at any time by giving one month's notice.
