

+HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA AT CHANDIGARH

ORDER

Dated, Chandigarh, the 2nd September, 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred under rule 6(1)(c) of the Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007, the Governor of Haryana, on the recommendation of this Court, is pleased to appoint the candidates namely **Sh. Navendu Jain and Sh. Bhupinder Kumar** as Additional District & Sessions Judges in the State of Haryana, purely on provisional basis from the date they take over as such, in the pay scale i.e. District Judge Entry Level (Level – J5) Rs.144840-194660 plus usual allowances as sanctioned by the Haryana Government from time to time, with further orders that these appointments are subject to the terms and conditions, i.e. **(i)** that they will be governed by the Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007 in Haryana as well as other rules/instructions in the matter of leave, conduct, discipline and appeal, medical attendance, provident fund/NPS, travelling allowance and all other service matters etc. framed by the Government of Haryana and issued from time to time; **(ii)** that their appointments are subject to the fulfillment of all necessary conditions laid down in rules; **(iii)** that their probation will be governed by Rule 13 of the Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007 and they will be on probation for a period of two years, from the date of joining duty as decided by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. These appointments are subject to the successful completion of probation period as per rules; **(iv)** that their appointment will be subject to the outcome of court case, if any, instituted/may be instituted in connection with their selection/appointment.
